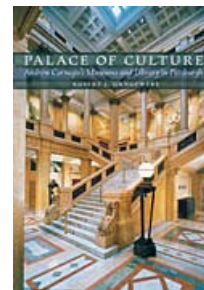

### Palace of Culture: Andrew Carnegie's Museums and Library in Pittsburgh

Andrew Carnegie believed that education and culture should not be the sole province of the wealthy. He created the "Free to the People" Carnegie Library in 1895, followed by the Carnegie Institute in 1896 which included a music hall, art museum and science museum.



Our guest speaker, Robert J. Gangewere, will share Carnegie's romantic vision for his "Palace of Culture" and discuss how it was fulfilled and reshaped over the past 100 years.

Robert J. Gangewere is a former editor of *Carnegie Magazine* and adjunct professor of English at Carnegie Mellon University.

He is the author of the new book, *Palace of Culture*, published by University of Pittsburgh Press.

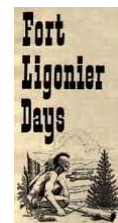
