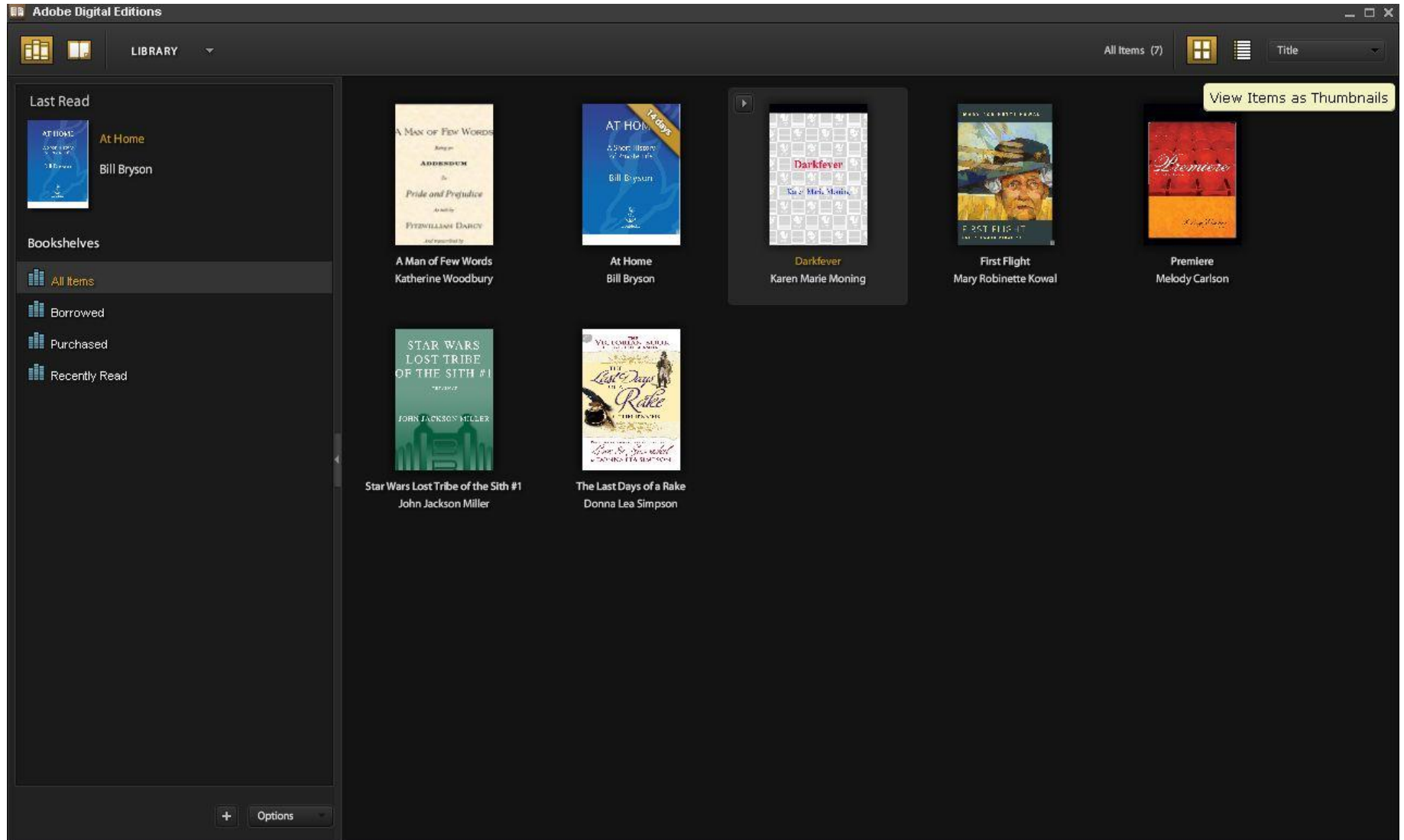

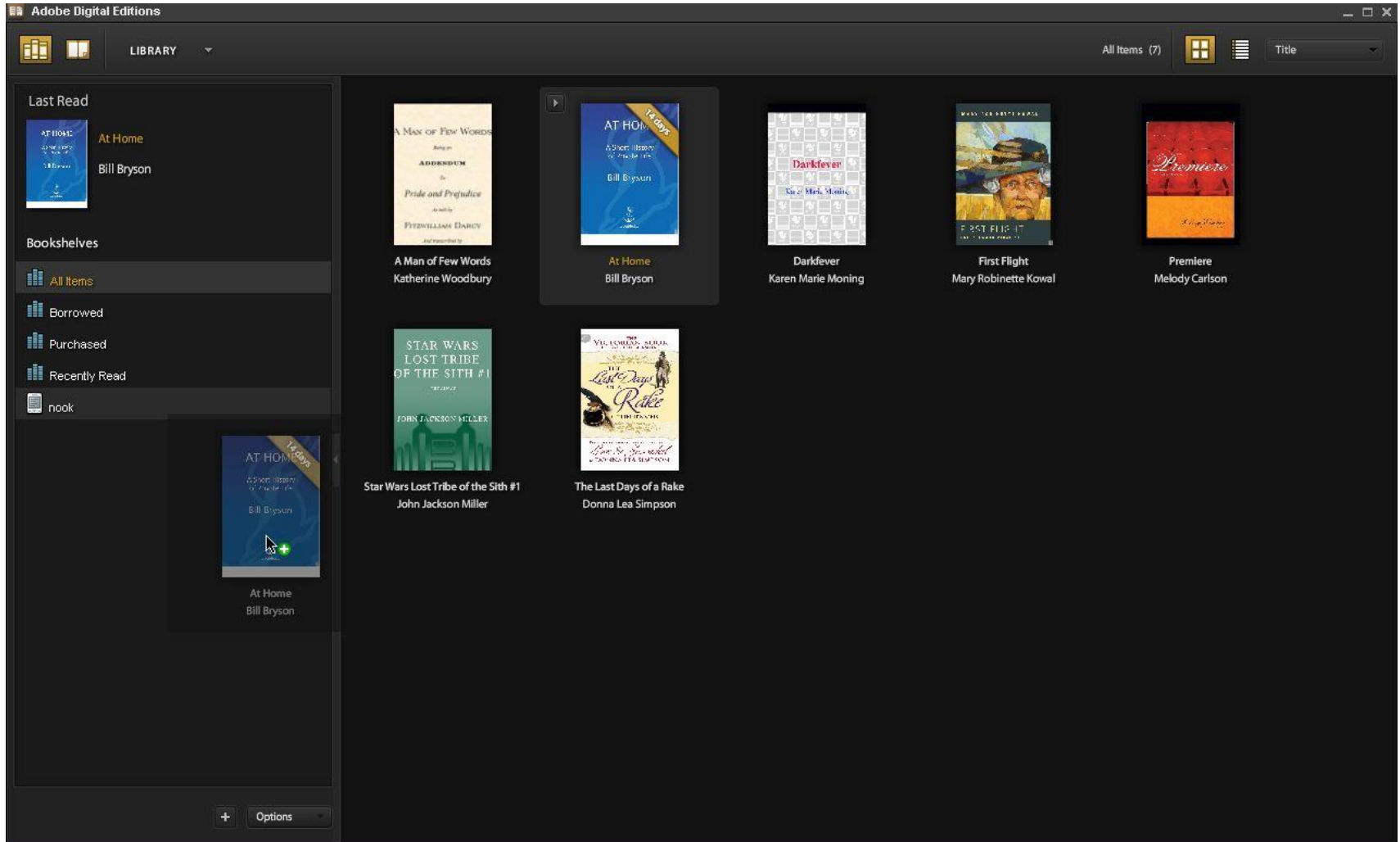




Connect compatible device (nook, Sony, Kobo, etc.) to computer.
