

# BORROWING EBOOKS WITH KINDLE EREADERS

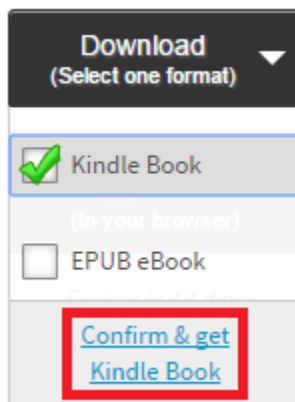


Kindle

Kindle eReaders have black and white screens and are only used to read eBooks. Older generations of Kindle eReaders might have a keyboard and might not have the ability to connect to WiFi networks.

## IF THE KINDLE EREADER CAN CONNECT TO WIFI:

1. Use a computer to go to [ebooks.wlnonline.org](http://ebooks.wlnonline.org)
2. Place the mouse on the book you would like to check out and click “Borrow.”
3. Enter your library card number.
4. Click “Download.”
5. Select “Kindle Book.”
6. Click “Confirm & get Kindle Book.” You will be redirected to Amazon.

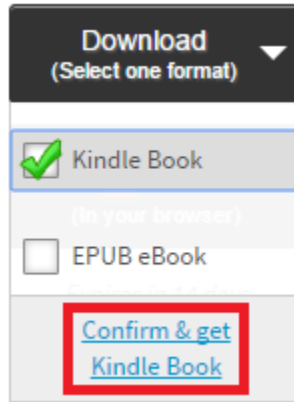


7. Click “Get library book” on the right side of the page.
8. Sign in using your Amazon username and password.
9. Select the device you would like the book to be delivered to.
10. Click “Continue.” The book will appear on your device.

## IF THE KINDLE EREADER CANNOT CONNECT TO WIFI:

1. Connect the Kindle to a computer via the USB cable
2. Use a computer to go to [ebooks.wlnonline.org](http://ebooks.wlnonline.org)
3. Place the mouse on the book you would like to check out and click “Borrow.”
4. Enter your library card number.

5. Click "Download."
6. Select "Kindle Book."
7. Click "Confirm & get Kindle Book." You will be redirected to Amazon.



8. Click "Get library book" on the right side of the page.
9. Sign in using your Amazon username and password.
10. Select "Transfer via Computer" from the dropdown menu.
11. Click "Continue."
12. Select the device you will transfer the eBook to.
13. If a prompt appears, click the circle next to "Save File" and click "Okay."



Select **Save File**, then click **OK**

14. Go to the Downloads folder on your computer. The eBook file should appear as an AZW3 File.
15. Drag the eBook file to the Kindle (it should be listed as a remote drive.)
