

NOOK & other eReaders

You will need:

- a Nook eReader or non-Kindle eReader
- a WLN library card
- the USB cord that came with your eReader
- Adobe Digital Editions
- a computer connected to the Internet

Setup:

1. Go to <http://www.adobe.com/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html>
2. Click "Download."
3. Click Macintosh or Windows, depending on if you use a Mac or PC.
4. Follow the prompts to install Digital Editions.
5. Click "Help."
6. Click "Authorize computer."
7. Select "Overdrive" from the dropdown menu.
8. If you have an Overdrive account, enter your email and password. If not, click "I want to authorize my computer without an ID."
9. Click "Authorize" or "Next."

Searching for and borrowing a book:

1. Use your computer to go to westmoreland.lib.overdrive.com/
2. Click in the search box (in the upper right corner) and type the title or author of the book you want to download.
3. Click the cover of the book you want to download.
4. Click "Borrow." (If the ebook is checked out by another user, the button will read "Place a Hold." Click this if you want to be notified by email when the ebook is available to checkout.)
5. Enter your library card number
6. Click "Download."
7. Click "EPUB."
8. Click "Confirm and download."

Reading a book:

1. Open Adobe Digital Editions.
2. Click "File" and "Add to library."
3. Open your Downloads folder. Your eBook should appear.
4. Click on the eBook. Click "Open."
5. Connect your Nook to your computer using the USB cord. Your Nook should appear on the left under "Devices."
6. Click the eBook, then drag it over to your device name on the left side of the screen.

Once the transfer is complete, you can read the eBook on your Nook.
